**MAWSS Offers Reward for Information on Vandalism Resulting in Overflow
6704 Bridgewood Ct.**

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) is offering a \$5000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the persons responsible for the vandalism, and consequent overflow, of a manhole that occurred November 2, near 6704 Bridgewood Ct. Approximately 700 gallons of wastewater overflowed into Milkhouse Creek as a result of a blockage caused by debris stuffed into the manhole. MAWSS crews removed an assortment of motors, balls, wood and other items. Anyone with information related to the incident is asked to contact the Mobile County Sheriff's Office.
