MAWSS Wastewater Treatment Plants to Receive National Awards

For the thirteenth consecutive year, Mobile Area Water and Sewer System's (MAWSS) C.C. Williams Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) will be recognized for perfect regulatory compliance by the National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA). MAWSS' Wright Smith Jr. Wastewater Treatment Plant will be honored for eleven perfect years. Both plants will receive Platinum Peak Performance Awards from NACWA and special recognition at the organization's Annual Meeting, July 15, in Portland, Oregon.

Earning these prestigious environmental awards is no easy feat. Wastewater treatment plants must achieve 100 percent compliance in meeting their National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit requirements for five consecutive years to be eligible. Each consecutive year puts them in more exclusive company. Last year the Williams Plant was one of only three in the country to receive a Platinum 12 award. The Smith Plant was one of seven to receive a Platinum 10 award.
