MAWSS Plants Recognized for Protecting the Environment

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System's (MAWSS) Wastewater Treatment Plants were awarded Platinum Peak Performance Awards from the National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA) signifying they had outstanding compliance records in the 2010 calendar year. The awards were presented during NACWA's 2011 Summer Conference and 41st Annual Meeting, held July 19-22, in Chicago, Illinois.

Platinum awards represent the highest level of achievement for wastewater treatment plants and are awarded to facilities that maintain perfect regulatory compliance in meeting permit discharge limits for five or more consecutive years. The C.C. Williams Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) was one of only four plants nationwide to be recognized for 10 consecutive years of perfect performance. The Wright Smith Jr. WWTP was one of nine plants recognized for eight years of perfect regulatory compliance.

"Receiving national awards for consecutive years is an outstanding achievement. We're proud of our treatment plant operators and their dedication to protecting the environment," said MAWSS Director Malcolm Steeves.
