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### **MAWSS Announces September Hydrant Flushing Schedule**

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) will be flushing fire hydrants throughout the Mobile area during the month of September. Flushing is a maintenance activity that involves opening the hydrants and allowing water to flow freely for a short period of time. Flushing helps maintain water quality by cleaning out sediment and other particulates that accumulate normally in the water mains. As a result of the flushing, water may appear milky or have some temporary discoloration. This discoloration does not affect the safety of the water. If discoloration or sediment is evident, customers may want to avoid doing laundry for that day. Allow water to run a few minutes to clear before using.

Locations scheduled to be flushed in September include neighborhoods near Hickory Lane, Timberly Rd. , Christopher Dr., Freemont Dr., Long Meadow, Pinehurst Subdivision, Westbury Dr., Regents Dr., Old Shell Rd. between Hillcrest Rd. and University Blvd., Shenandoah Dr., Brandy Run, Colonial Oaks Subdivision, Shelton Beach Rd., Overlook Rd. at Moffett Rd., Forest Dale Dr. and Forest Hill Dr.
