MAWSS Inducts Five into Employee Hall of Fame

Mobile, Ala - The most important resource of any organization is its employees. Recognizing that fact, Mobile Area Water and Sewer System (MAWSS) began an Employee Hall of Fame program in 2009, that annually honors retirees who made lasting contributions to the organization. This year, five retirees were inducted during a brief ceremony March 23, at MAWSS Park Forest Plaza.

To be eligible, past employees must have exhibited a strong work ethic, loyalty, good attitude and dedication. This year's inductees were Stephen (Andy) Claxton Sr., Robert J. Wells Jr., Henry L. Scott, Walter Hamilton and the late Billy R. Maloy.

"These employees laid the foundation for a great organization that provides critical services to the community," said MAWSS Director Charles Hyland. "Their dedication showed loyalty to the organization as well as to their fellow employees."

This year's inductees represent 136 years of service. Since its inception, 56 retirees have been inducted to the Employee Hall of Fame representing 1,677 years of service to the community. The names of all the inductees can be seen on the Employee Hall of Fame plaque displayed in the Wesley James Operations Center at MAWSS Park Forest Plaza.
