MAWSS Announces November Hydrant Flushing Schedule

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) will be flushing fire hydrants in west Mobile during the month of November. Flushing is a maintenance activity that involves opening the hydrants and allowing water to flow freely for a short period of time. Flushing helps maintain water quality by cleaning out sediment and other particulates that accumulate normally in the water mains. As a result of the flushing, water may appear milky or have some temporary discoloration. Allow water to run a few minutes to clear before using. Avoid doing laundry as staining can occur.
