### **MAWSS Announces March Hydrant Flushing Schedule**

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) will be flushing fire hydrants in the west Mobile area during the month of March. Flushing is a maintenance activity that involves opening the hydrants and allowing water to flow freely for a short period of time. Flushing helps maintain water quality by cleaning out sediment and other particulates that accumulate normally in the water mains. As a result of the flushing, water may appear milky or have some temporary discoloration. Allow water to run a few minutes to clear before using. Avoid doing laundry as staining can occur.

Locations scheduled to be flushed in March include Richmond Subdivision, McFarland and Johnson Roads, Snow and Jeff Hamilton Roads, Dawes Point Subdivision, Randlette Trace Subdivision, Heritage Woods Subdivision, Crystal Key Subdivision, Autumn Ridge Subdivision and Scott Dairy Loop.
