MAWSS' Lindblom Recognized by Alabama's Water Environment Association

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) Regulatory Compliance Officer Suzanne Lindblom was this year's recipient of the Hatfield Award presented by Alabama's Water Environment Association (AWEA) for outstanding performance and professionalism in the operation of a wastewater treatment facility. The award was presented during AWEA's Annual Conference in Orange Beach in April.

Lindblom began her career at MAWSS in 2011 as Lab Manager where she oversaw lab analysis and quality control for the utility's two water and wastewater treatment plants. She is an active participant with AWEA's professional education and community outreach and was awarded the Laboratory Analysts Award in 2014. Her promotion to Regulatory Compliance Officer in 2016 adds all water and sewer regulatory reporting activities for MAWSS, as well as oversight of the Pre-Treatment Program to her duties. She holds a bachelor's degree in Biological Sciences and a master's in Aquatic Ecology from the University of Alabama.

The Hatfield Award is named for Dr. William D. Hatfield, former Superintendent of the Decatur, Illinois Sanitary District, who was President of the Central States Sewage Works Association in 1944-45 and served as President of Water Environment Federation in 1958-59.
