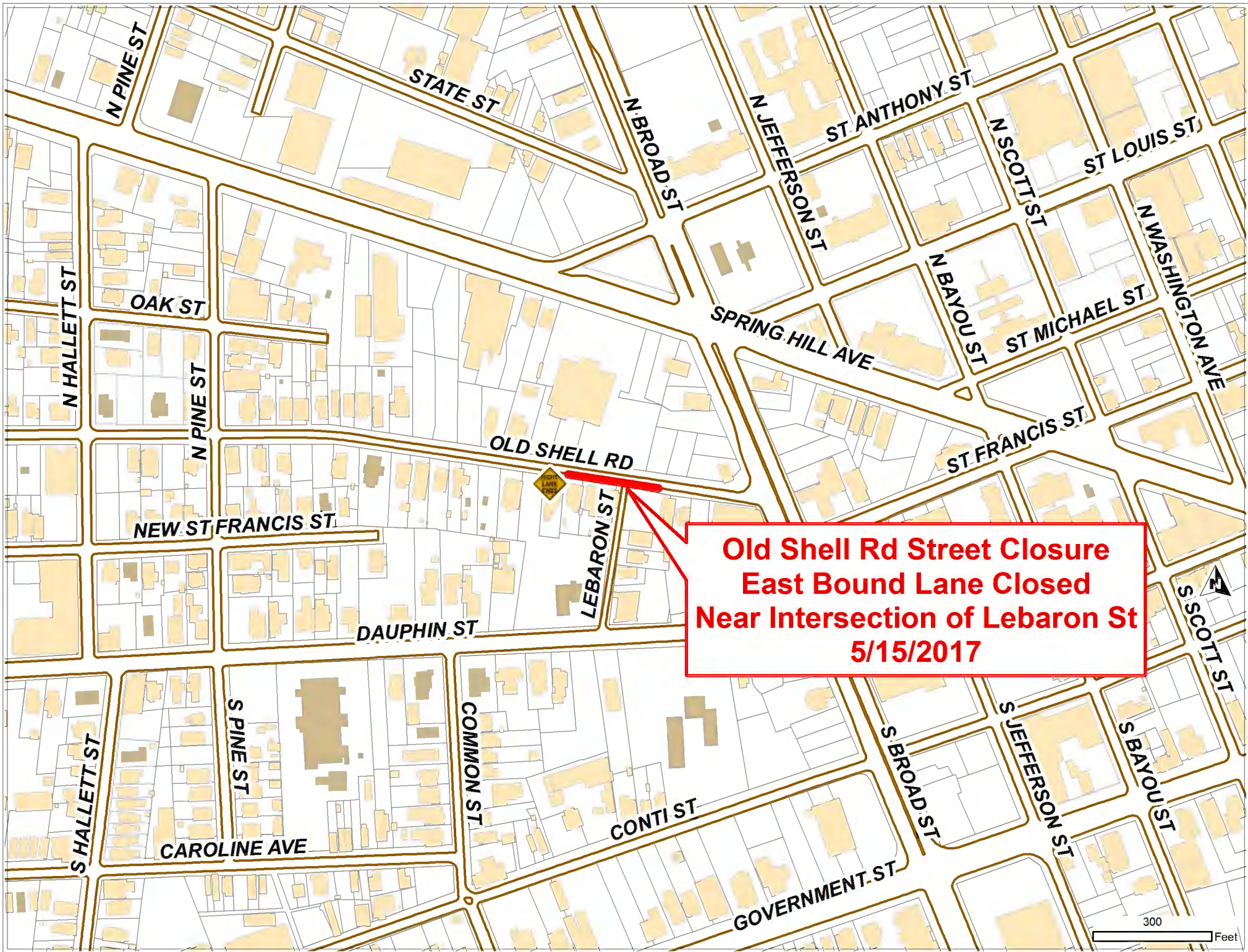
MAWSS to Relocate Water Lines; Service Disruptions Possible

Contractors for Mobile Area Water and Sewer System (MAWSS) will be relocating water lines the week of May 15-19. Most of the projects are taking place in the evening to minimize service and traffic interruptions. During those times MAWSS advises some customers may experience brief water outages, temporary discoloration of water and traffic detours. The schedule of work is as follows:

May 15	Old Shell Road and LeBaron Street	8 a.m. – 5 p.m.	Map 01
May 16	Government St. and S. Catherine St.	10 p.m.- 6 a.m.	Map 02
May 17	Government St. and S. Bayou St	7 p.m. – 3 a.m.	Map 03
May 18	Water St. at S. Royal and Monroe St.	7 p.m. – 6 a.m.	Map 04

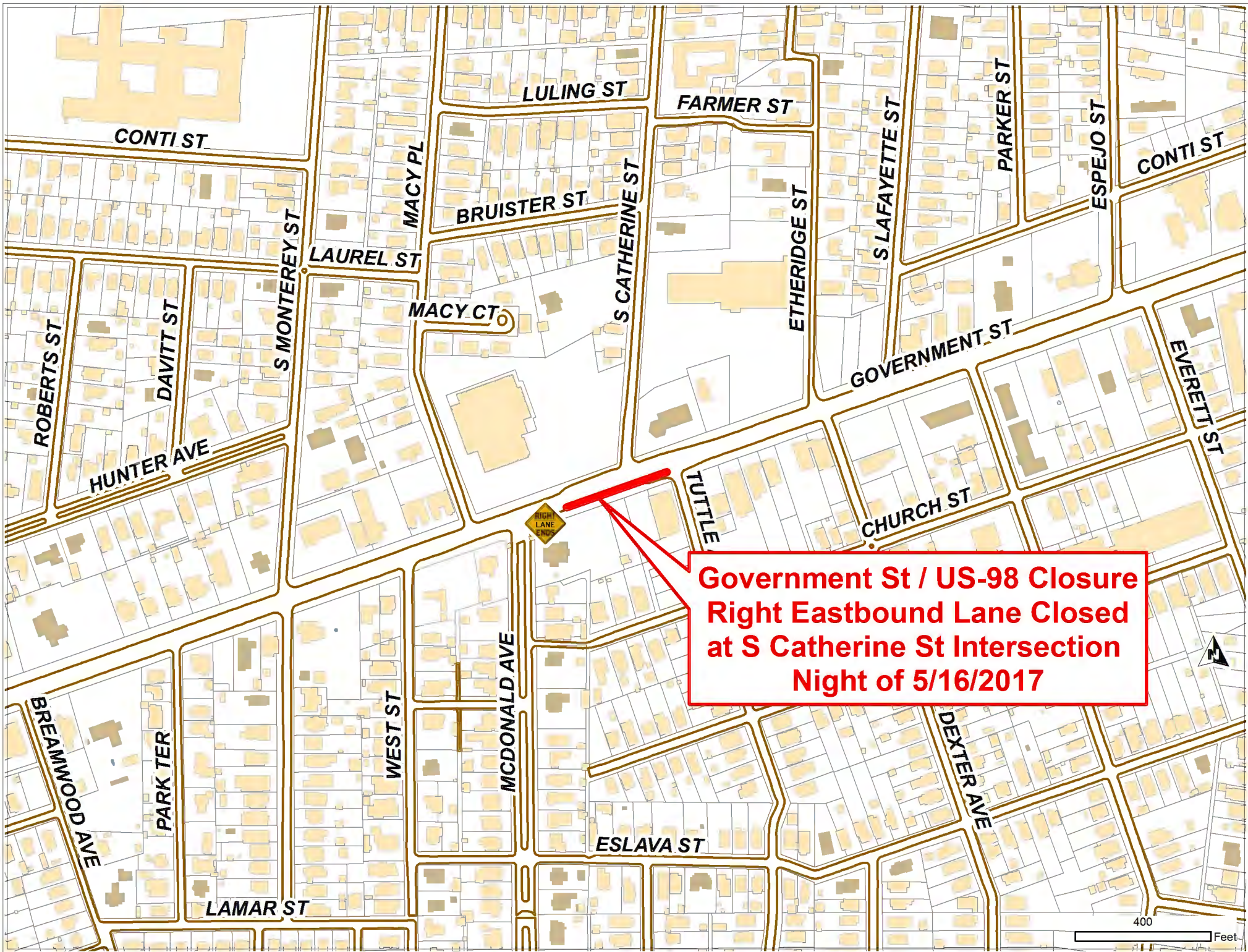
Water may appear cloudy after the shutdown due to depressurizing of the line. The cloudiness is caused by air bubbles trapped in the water. These will disappear if the water is allowed to sit a few minutes. If water is discolored, allow it to run for a few minutes. Please refrain from washing clothes or dishes until water is cleared as it may cause staining.

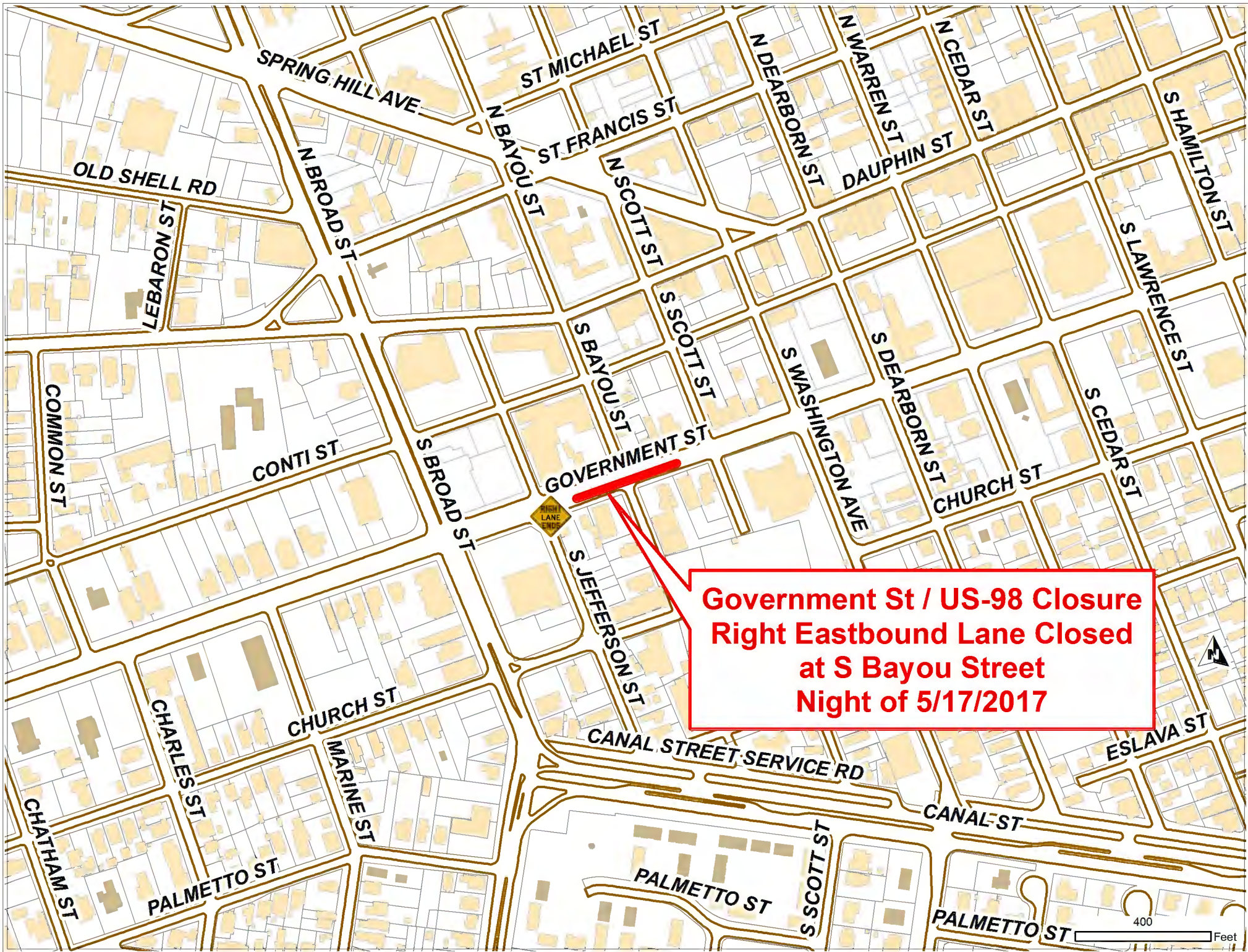

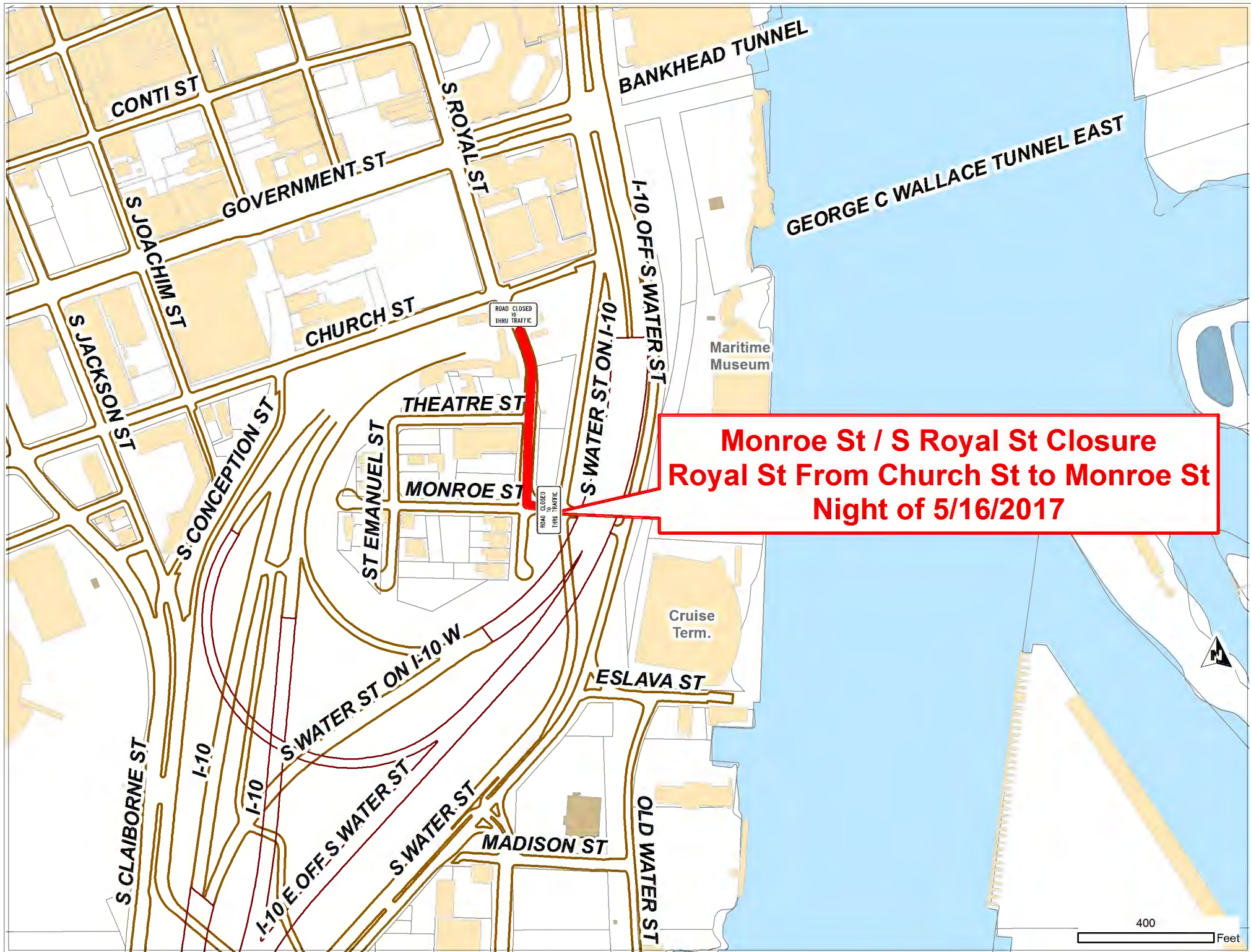




**Government St / US-98 Closure
