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MAWSS Sets Supplier Diversity Fair Aug. 2

Some of the services and materials sought include large and small equipment rentals, bypass pumps, carpentry, concrete paving, curbing and finishing, backfill and topsoil, piping insulation, plumbing, asphalt paving, pavement marking, debris removal and hauling, easement restoration, landscaping, sodding and irrigation, electrical work, piping supplies, security systems and personnel, site cleanup and janitorial, surveying, engineering, traffic control, masonry, drywall, painting, office supplies and printing, geotechnical services, underwater diving, fencing and more.
