MAWSS Announces November Hydrant Flushing Schedule

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) will be flushing fire hydrants throughout the Mobile area during the month of November. Flushing is a maintenance activity that involves opening the hydrants and allowing water to flow freely for a short period of time. Flushing helps maintain water quality by cleaning out sediment and other particulates that accumulate normally in the water mains. As a result of the flushing, water may appear milky or have some temporary discoloration. Allow water to run a few minutes to clear before using. Avoid doing laundry as staining can occur.

Locations scheduled to be flushed in November include Spring Grove Rd., Saddlebrook Subdivision, Hamilton Creek Subdivision, Malibar Heights Subdivision, Japonica Lane, Azalea & Cottage Hill, Lakeside Dr., Burma Rd. Area, Dawes Pointe, Scott Dairy Loop, Dawes Lake Rd. and Randlett Trace.
