MAWSS Announces October Hydrant Flushing Schedule

Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) will be flushing fire hydrants throughout the Mobile area during the month of October. Flushing is a maintenance activity that involves opening the hydrants and allowing water to flow freely for a short period of time. Flushing helps maintain water quality by cleaning out sediment and other particulates that accumulate normally in the water mains. During flushing, residents and business owners may experience notice discoloration of water. Residents and business owners are encouraged to check your water prior to washing clothing as staining may occur.

Locations scheduled to be flushed in October include Colonial Circle, Shelton Beach Road, Mississippi St., Forest Dale / Forest Hill, Border Circle, Ridgelawn, Wolf Ridge Road, Springhill, Mobile Country Club, Michael Blvd. and Regency Oaks Subdivision.
