## Addendum #1 - IFB 24-017 Replacement Backwash Pumps

Prospective Bidders:

## Answers to questions/comments received:

 Pump Specification 2.5 A4 indicates that all components in contact with potable water are to be "NSF/ANSI 61 certified." Can this be changed to "must have NSF/ANSI 61 compliant materials" identical to the Hillcrest Pumps? The same rubber bearing manufacturer and NSF61-compliant coatings as specified shall be used.

Answer to Question 1: Either will be acceptable for this project.

2. Pump Specification 2.5 F specifies pump impellers to be nickel-aluminum-bronze. We request approval of the Morrison standard of forged 316L stainless steel impeller, identical to the Hillcrest Pumps.

<u>Answer to Question 2</u>: Yes, the material listed will be acceptable for this application for any bidders.

3. If we use the existing soleplates, can we quote the pumps with <u>installation support</u> and <u>start-up</u> <u>services</u>, but without the actual installation (cranes, etc.)?

Answer to Question 3: No, we won't allow this.
