### **Detours as progress is Being Made on a Large Sewer Project in The Crenshaw Street Area**

*Mobile, AL* -There is a revised schedule for traffic detours due to the Crenshaw Street lift station and force main improvements project. The project includes the installation of a new 16” sanitary sewer force main from the Crenshaw Street lift station to the newly constructed Three Mile Creek trunk sewer. It’s all in an effort to further alleviate sanitary sewer overflows.

The Woodlands Avenue/Spring Hill Avenue intersection will be closed on Monday morning, December 5, 2022 as Mobile Area Water & Sewer System contractors adjust traffic signals in advance of boring in the vicinity. On December 5th until December 16<sup>th</sup>, Woodlands Avenue will be closed and a boring rig will be set up at the entrance to that area. December 17<sup>th</sup> to a date to be determined the road will be open. We will not close it again until the force main tie-ins, restoration, and pavement work begin. We will notify everyone a week before this work is scheduled to proceed. Door hangers will be placed on your front door. This will likely not happen before February 3, 2023.

The five-million-dollar project is expected to be completed by the end of 2023. It includes the following areas: Levert Drive, Woodlands Avenue, Springhill Avenue, Upham Street, Dauphin Street, Mohawk Street, Emogene Street, and Crenshaw Street.
