**Street Closure on Route of Crenshaw Street Sewer Project**

MOBILE, AL, November 15, 2022 -- Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) contractors working on the Crenshaw Street lift station and force main upgrades will need to close the entrance of Woodlands Avenue. All residents will have access to their homes from the detour route. The street will be closed Thursday, November 17th and remain closed until approximately February 3, 2023.

MAWSS is holding a community meeting Tuesday, November 15, 2022 at 5:30 pm at Murphy High School (cafeteria) regarding the project. The upgrades include the installation of a new 16” sanitary sewer force main from the Crenshaw Street lift station to the newly constructed Three Mile Creek trunk sewer in an effort to further alleviate sanitary sewer overflows in this area.

The five-million-dollar project is expected to be completed by the end of 2023. It includes the following areas: Levert Drive, Woodlands Avenue, Springhill Avenue, Upham Street, Dauphin Street, Mohawk Street, Emogene Street, and Crenshaw Street.

Engineers and others involved with the project will be on hand to answer any questions.

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
