Commissioner St. John called the meeting to order and Commissioner Williams gave the invocation.

There were no Committee Reports or Visitors present requesting an audience with the Board.

The **Minutes of October 6, 2025** were presented for approval. Commissioner Bell moved for approval and Commissioner Williams seconded. The motion then carried with the unanimous vote of the Board present.

Item 6A Garver USA Project No. W10-2401555-Stickney WTP Basin Structural Rehabilitation

*Note: This bid was listed on the agenda under Information Only Item 10W as a prequalification.

The engineers estimate for this project is \$4,376,000; there were three bidders. The apparent low bidder is Gulf Coast Underground, LLC., in the amount of \$1,893,450. Staff requests approval granting the Director the authority to award this project upon recommendation of the engineer and review by the DBE Department.

Commissioner Williams clarified, if the review process of the specifications does not confirm low, qualified bidder status, staff will bring this item back to the Board; he then moved for approval. Commissioner Bell seconded and the motion then carried with the unanimous vote of the Board present.

Item 6B McCrory & Williams Project No. M5712-2700 Perch Creek Area Sanitary Sewer Trunk Line CIPP Phase II

The engineers estimate for this project is \$5,800,000; there were three bidders. The apparent low bidder is BLD Services, LLC., in the amount of \$1,454,640. Staff requests approval granting the Director the authority to award this project upon recommendation of the engineer and review by the DBE Department.

Commissioner Bell moved for approval; Commissioner Zoghby seconded and the motion then passed with the unanimous vote of the Board present.

Item 6C McCrory & Williams Project No. M5712-2840 2026 Annual Contract for Roadway Bores

The engineers estimate for this project is \$500,000; there was one bidder. The apparent low bidder is Construction Labor Services, Inc., in the amount of \$679,980. Staff will bring this item back to the Board at a later date.

Item 6D McCrory & Williams Project No. M5712-2841 2026 Annual Contract for Cured-In-Place Pipe Rehabilitation of the Public Portion of Sanitary Sewer Lateral

The engineers estimate for this project is \$2,500,000; there were two bidders. The apparent low bidder is BLD Services, LLC., in the amount of \$1,876,250. Staff will bring this item back to the Board at a later date.

Commissioner Bell moved for approval and Commissioner Williams seconded. The motion then carried with the unanimous vote of the Board present.
