Mobile Area Water & Sewer System (MAWSS) responded to numerous wastewater overflows in the Mobile area. Wastewater overflows occur when heavy rainfall infiltrate the sewer system. MAWSS is addressing overflows with capital projects. Below are the documented locations, accumulated totals and receiving waters.
