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Debris Blockage Cause Sanitary Sewer Overflows

Mobile Area Water and Sewer System (MAWSS) experienced multiple sanitary sewer overflows as a result of a debris blockage on a sewer main line. MAWSS crews have cleared the blockage. Below are the overflow locations, their estimated volumes and receiving water.
